Biographical Note



John R. Spencer Q.C., LLD was a Professor of Law at the University of Cambridge until his retirement in September 2013, when he became a Professor Emeritus. In a career lasting over 40 years he has written extensively on criminal law, criminal evidence and comparative criminal procedure, including on law enforcement and police cooperation. His interests include European criminal law. In particular, he was a member of the international team responsible for drafting the Corpus Juris project. Besides his book (with Mireille Delmas-Marty) on European criminal procedures, he has written or edited books dealing with various aspects of the law of evidence in England and Wales, and also a short book in French about English criminal procedure. He is the ECLAN Contact Point for the United Kingdom. He is Life Fellow of Selwyn College, Cambridge, and a Bye-Fellow of Murray Edwards College, Cambridge.
